Terms and Conditions

1. Technical Information

1.1 Match Pitch Measurements

- **U11 Age Group:** 50m x 30m, with goal size 5m x 2m.
- **U12 Age Group:** 50m x 30m, with goal size 5m x 2m.

1.2 Eligibility

- U11 Age Group: Players born after 1 January 2014 (eligible for the 2025 season).
- U12 Age Group: Players born after 1 January 2013 (eligible for the 2025 season).

1.3 Match Duration

- Each game will last **1x18 minutes** with no halftime.
- If a match starts late, the playtime will be reduced to ensure subsequent matches begin on time.
- No stoppage or injury time will be added under any circumstances, including finals matches.

1.4 Team Composition

• Teams will consist of **9 players total**: 8 outfield players and 1 goalkeeper (SAP standard).

1.5 Match Ball

• MUFC will supply a match ball for each game. A size 4 ball will be used for both age groups.

1.6 Player Equipment

• All players must wear their full team uniform, football boots, and shin pads.

1.7 Scoring System

- Win: 3 points.
- Draw: 1 point.
- Loss: 0 points.
- Forfeit For: 3 points (+3 goal difference).
- Forfeit Against: 0 points (-3 goal difference).

1.8 Group Stage Ranking Teams will be ranked based on:

- 1. Most points.
- 2. Goal difference.
- 3. Most goals scored.
- 4. Head-to-head results (if only two teams are involved).
- 1.9 Rules and Compliance All matches will be played in compliance with:
 - FFA and Football NSW By-laws, regulations, codes, and directives.
 - The Laws of the Game as approved by FIFA.

2.0 Referees

• Each game will have an **appointed referee**.

Disciplinary Policy:

Manly United FC (MUFC) has a ZERO Tolerance stance on any form of anti-social behaviour or violent behaviour or conduct.

All players, spectators and officials are to abide by the Football NSW and <u>Football Australia Code of</u> <u>Conduct</u> (*The Code*). *The Code* will be made available prior to the event and will be available on the day.

Any person(s) that are found guilty by a MUFC Official or Match Official will be subject to immediate disciplinary action appropriate to the offence. This may include referral to governing bodies within MUFC, Football NSW or Football Australia, or in the event of a breach deemed to be punishable by law enforcement, a referral may be made to the NSW Police.

MUFC reserves the right to remove or disqualify any team or their spectators found to be in breach of *The Code* and in breach of the ZERO Tolerance stance on anti-social and violent behaviour. MUFC also reserves the right to remove any spectator from the venue who is deemed to have breached *The Code* or the ZERO Tolerance Policy.
